So, as permitted by state law and with the assistance of Pastor Schwartz, he and I searched the boys' backpacks and clothes and Miss Detweiler and Miss Lily searched the girls' backpacks and clothes. We also search the lockers and desks. Unfortunately, we did not find the money.

Please warn your children (1) NOT to bring valuables to school, and (2) turn any payments of money in at the office as soon as they come to school so that they are not responsible if they get lost.

I am sorry to need to ask this of you. It has been many years since we have had to deal with kind of issue. Pray that God would work in the heart of the student who is taking the money and convict him/her of his/her wrong choices so that he/she can be forgiven and the loss can be made right.
