Saturday, 13 May - **ACSI Track Meet**, Bangor, PA. Students meet at school in time to leave at 6:00 a.m. SHARP. Students will be returned to their homes in the evening around 8:00-9:00 p.m. Money will be needed for food and a poncho and change of clothes for rain.
